ony was indirectly introduced to Yukiko by Minneapolis vocalist Patricia Lacy-Aiken. In 2001 Patricia showed Tony a concert video from Japan which featured a vocalist friend of hers, and he noticed the piano player in the band, it was Yukiko. Inspired by her musical energy, but never having met, he looked up her website, and emailed her on a lark. They began to correspond through emails and decided to meet during an upcoming trip to Japan. Yukiko sent Tony several of her CD's to listen to. Tony recalls his first impression of Yukiko's music, "As soon as I heard it, I fell in love with it. It was beautiful, sensitive. and from the heart. I knew then that I wanted to produce her next CD." One of Yukiko's CD's in particular, 'The New Style of Euphonium,' stayed with Tony. Yukiko had composed and produced the CD for a gifted instrumentalist and concert performer named Yuko Narita who played the euphonium (a brass instrument closely related to the French horn). She had recorded the CD right before her tragic death in a car crash in October of 2001.

Yukiko is still haunted by the loss of her dear friend and Yuko's spirit and memory have become an important part of September Light.

ukiko met Tony in 2002. He was traveling with Jeff Peabody and friend Takashi Yasumi. Together they attended the Marcus Miller performance at the Blue Note in Tokyo. Jeff is also the talented photographer that took all of the photos featured in this DVD. Before Yukiko left for a concert tour in China, she met Tony at a pub in Kichijoji where they talked about their mutual influences and musical visions. When Tony told Yukiko how moved he was by her composing and producing on The New Style of Euphonium.

Yukiko told the poignant story of Yuko Narita and expressed her desire to dedicate a CD to her memory. The songs 'Still Beside Me (Dear Y)' and 'In A Single Moment' were written expressly for Yuko.

ony gave Yukiko a CD of his music that night, immediately after she heard it she emailed Tony and told him how moved she was by his music, his art of production, and his voice. She was amazed and impressed that one person had done everything on the CD. When she returned to Japan from China, they met one last time the night before Tony was scheduled to fly home. They spent hours playing music together, and it was then that Yukiko announced her concept of recording a CD of both her and Tony's music. Tony was inspired by this idea, and knew that it was a rare chance to create and record the music he had always heard in his heart.
